The Longest Day and it is exceedingly hot. The garden is being watered but despite the heat there are a variety of plants flowering. The meadow is yellow with Corn Marigold, with specks of blue Corn Flowers and red Poppies. The blue Flax flowers have appeared and there are Opium Poppies.



The tall *Verbena bonariensis* stands stately in borders alongside Scabious. The climbing Passion Flower has many flowers with the promise of orange fruit later in the year.

Damselflies are coupled and laying eggs in the pond.
