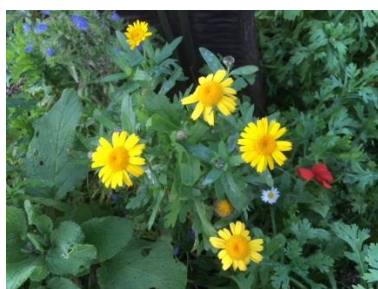


Garden Blog - Wednesday 29th November
